### *“The Ethics of Psychoanalysis and the Others”*

*Psychoanalytic ethics, on the other hand, is the ethics that, whether recognized or not, guides the psychoanalytic act on a day-to-day basis in psychoanalysis, whenever there is psychoanalysis. It shares with the ethics of our time the characteristic of being **optional**; it is not for everyone, but requires a specific, new desire, the desire called by Lacan ... the desire of the analyst. No less unspeakable than any other, but a desire of exception whose concept remains to be clarified, because contrary to what vectors each individual desire, it is carried neither by the signifying chain of an “I”, nor by the object it engages. Yet, it is this desire that causes the analyzing desire. Lacan speaks of this **ethics of desire**, which counters the imperatives of the loud voice of the superego, and whose path - "avenue," according to Lacan's term – follows that of the demand, and in Remarks on Daniel Lagache's Presentation, Lacan calls it an ethics "of silence"<sup>1</sup>, an ethics "converted to silence" by the fact that desire, "incompatible with speech", is unspeakable.*
